

# 7 STEPS TO SPILL MANAGEMENT

## 1

### ALERT

- Report it to your Supervisor.
- Get the spill team together.
- Clear the area.



## 2

### ASSESS

- Check for other hazards.
- Switch off heat, power, and ignition.
- Mark the exclusion zone.



## 3

### IDENTIFY

- Stop. Identify the spill. Then approach.
- Look for labels, colours, markings and the Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) to help.



## 4

### RESPOND

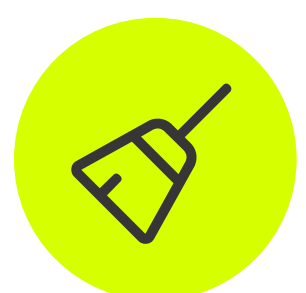
- Suit up with the right PPE.
- Contain the spill with pads or granules.
- Work outside in, in circles.



## 5

### CLEAN

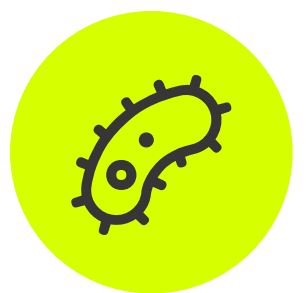
- Clean up with brushes, mops, and wipes.
- Bag all used tools and contaminated items.



## 6

### DECONTAMINATE

- Take off and rinse clothing.
- Keep clean items away from contaminated gloves.
- Rinse or dispose of all equipment.



## 7

### REPORT

- Tell your Supervisor about every spill.
- If it's a reportable quantity, alert the right authority.
